The artist has long photographed the landscape and the passage of time, as evidenced by the ravages of the sun and the changing seasons.

Having first become enamored with the beauty of the central coast and its wine country when visiting in 1979, Pindelski has made his home in Templeton, California for many years, together with his wife, son and border terrier. In addition to taking photographs, he cultivates Zinfandel grapes on his vineyard.

The artist's prizewinning work has been extensively published in the US and the UK.

ABOUT THE PHOTOGRAPHS

These photographs of central California depict the coastal and winegrowing regions from Limekiln State Park in the north to Avila Beach in the south.

These Giclée prints are made to last, using archival processes and mounted on high quality museum board with acid free mats.

Signed prints are available in 18" x 24" and 13" x 19" sizes. Both sizes are mounted on 22" x 28" board. Prints are available framed or unframed and are limited to an edition of 25. A signed, numbered Certificate of Authenticity is attached to the back of each photograph.

Frames are of high quality black ash protected with glass and framed prints are ready to hang.
